Let's try to meet around 6:30.

If you can, send me a message letting me know if you ca make it.

Here's a tentative agenda:

- 1. Updates from everyone regarding collection of names, and setting a schedule for when we realistically think all 400 names can be collected and entered into a spreadsheet.
- 2. Discussion of locations where kits can be delivered. Pastor Harris is checking with others in his group about churches in each of the city's four quadrants that might be able to participate. We can discuss other options as well. But we have to get this nailed down because Marc is about ready to ship.
- 3. Volunteer helpers. Talked with Marc about this and he thought they weren't needed, and that the trouble wasn't worth the effort. I'd like to discuss the issue anyway. Marc's view is that even if only 1/3 get returned, we are still beating by far the test the city did. Even so, I think if we ca arrive at the right number of people, we can come close to hitting 300. For one thing, it triples the chances of finding problems if they exist, which is a primary purpose of this investigation. One important point raised by Mark is that their could be some liability, so anyone actually going to a person's home has to be very trustworthy. Maybe we could figure out other ways of following-up -- phone calls, emails, to keep after people to follow through on getting the tests done and sent off. So there are a lot of things to consider.
- 4. Documentation. Filmmaker Kate Levy, who has been working on Flint water issues with me, suggested having people record their tests on camera phones to be able to prove they are doing it right if the results get questioned. Any other ideas along those lines?
- 5. If the city doesn't already know what we are up to, they soon will. Given that the time for stealth has passed, what do people think about holding a press conference? One possibility, now that word is getting out, is that some other reporter will find out about this and do a story about it. It's better that we frame the issue. It could also help us get to 400 names if that becomes a problem. But there may also be downsides. Again, worth at least some discussion. I'll also talk with people on the communication's team here as well to see what they say.

- 6. Feel free to suggest other items for discussion so that people can think about them beforehand if they want.
- 7. I keep thinking about what we are doing, and how important it is. It is a big undertaking under any circumstances, but given the time crunch -- our deadline to have all testing done and in the mail is Sept, 1 -- there are multiple pressures at work here. It is a big job with a lot riding on the outcome. Even so, we need to have a few laughs, because they lighten our load. So come prepared to have at least a little bit of fun.

Lee is going to be laid up about a week, but I talked with her yesterday about a tentative plan. However, I think it is very important that we get a consensus on our next steps.

Marc says that the testing is going to be wrapped up by Wednesday, Sept. 9.
