Dr. Laura Sullivan is a Professor of Mechanical Engineering at Kettering University. Dr. Sullivan was an Associate on FACHEP project.

This witness stated that she met Dr. McElmurry at a Flint Water Crisis Task Force meeting. This witness stated that they both attended various meetings with researchers, scientists, physicians and the public pertaining to the Flint Water Crisis. She recalled first meeting McElmurry in Spring 2015. This witness stated that she believed that he was volunteering services towards the water crisis. This witness stated that McElmurry never spoke about a Hydraulic Model. Their interaction was mainly with people, their needs and water testing. This witness stated that McElmurry appeared to be knowledgeable, a good listener and spoke well to the community. This witness further stated nothing about her interaction with the licensee led her to believe he would falsify or misrepresent qualifications. This witness stated McElmurry was knowledgeable regarding the water crisis; when he lacked knowledge, he made sure someone else who was knowledgeable in the area was available. This witness stated McElmurry was a good teacher because he was able to convey an understanding of issues to physicians, scientists and residents.
